

UK Sets 2027 Target for Carbon Border Tax, Eyeing Level Playing Field

Britain plans to introduce a carbon border tax by 2027 to protect domestic manufacturers and level the playing field with foreign competitors, the government announced Monday.

Imports of iron, steel, ceramics, cement, and other goods from countries with weaker carbon pricing will be subject to a levy, ensuring UK producers facing steeper emission costs aren't undercut.

"This levy will ensure **carbon-intensive products** from overseas face comparable pricing to those made in the UK, encouraging global emissions reductions alongside our own decarbonization efforts," said **Finance Minister Jeremy Hunt**.
